

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act

CRRSA ACT DISCLOSURE JULY 31,2021

In April 2021 Yeshiva Toras Chaim began awarding HEERF 2 funding to students demonstrating “exceptional need” as required by the US Department of Education.

For purposes of HEERF 2 funding, Yeshiva Toras Chaim has prioritized all those receiving Federal Pell Grants. Remaining funds will be distributed with a Professional Judgement application process that will ask for detailed information about the individual student’s COVID-19 disruption and their need for funding. Students will be alerted of the application process.

For all students receiving HEERF 2 funding, note that you may opt-in to using the funds to pay any outstanding charges on your student account, or you may choose to receive the funds as a direct payment via check.

1. The total amount of funds Yeshiva Toras Chaim received from the U.S. Department of Education for this distribution to students is \$173,876
2. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act as of June 30, 2021, is \$173,876.
3. The estimated total number of students at Yeshiva Toras Chaim eligible to participate in programs under section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under section 18004(a)(1) of the Cares Act is 100.
4. The total number of students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act as of June 30, 2021 is 79.
