- Institutions who received funds under the CARES Act (HEERF I) were not required to submit an application to receive funds under the ARP Act (HEERF III). Yeshiva Toras Chaim received its HEERF III grant award notification on 5/21/2021 and performed its first drawdown of the funds 6/29/21. Yeshiva Toras Chaim will use no less than \$462,088, to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants directly to students.
- The total amount of funds that the institution has received for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP /HEERF III is \$462,088
- The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the ARP (HEERF III) as of September 30,2021, was \$5680
- The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP/HEERF III is 100.
- The total number of students who had received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the ARP was 3 as of September 30,2021.
- For purposes of ARP HEERF III funding, Yeshiva Toras Chaim has prioritized all those receiving Federal Pell Grants. Remaining funds will be distributed with a Professional Judgement application process that will ask for detailed information about the individual student's COVID-19 disruption and their need for funding. Students will be alerted of the application process.
- The instructions, directions, and guidance provided by Yeshiva Toras Chaim to all students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants were sent along with the funds, including where the students can find any updated details on the HEERF Website.
